Motivations include:

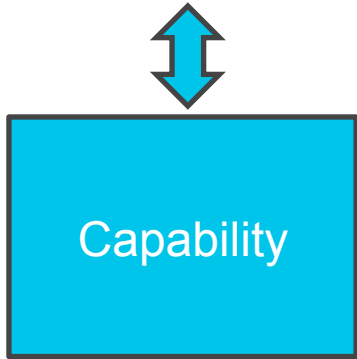
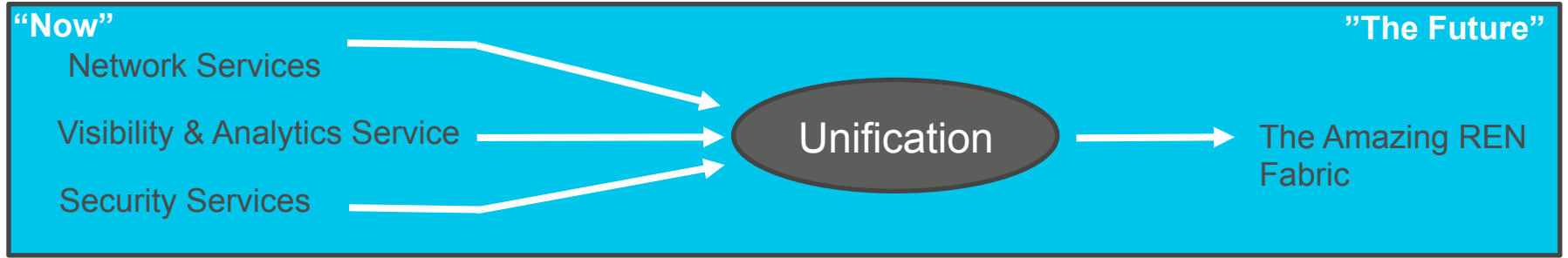
- We want to deliver value to our Members. DC Connect is an example of this

CORE PRINCIPLES

- **Principle 1:** Unification : Vision for technology and software in the Networking space
- **Principle 2:** Deliver at institutional level, think communal (values around technology and our role as an enabler within our community)
- **Principle 3:** Our value proposition : service, member knowledge and intimacy and getting the right things done.

PRINCIPLE 2: DELIVER INSTITUTIONAL THINK COMMUNAL

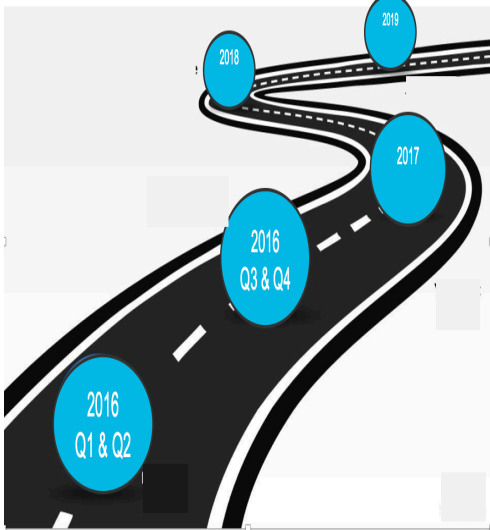
- Avoid the Tragedy of the Commons (“is a situation where individuals acting independently and rationally according to their own self-interest behave contrary to the best interests of the whole by depleting some common resource” Willian Forster Loyd)
- Illustrate a few points
 - Common Resource (Hardware, controls, self service)
 - Best Interests (financial, capacity, scale)

PRINCIPLE 3: VALUE PROP

 - Building relationships
 - Satisfying unique needs
 - Want to go the extra mile
